

PHOTOSHOP KEYBOARD SHORTCUTS

TOOLS

- M – marquee
- L – lasso
- C – crop
- J – healing brush/patch tool
- S – clone stamp
- E – eraser
- R – blur/sharpen/smudge
- A – path selection
- P – pen
- N – notes
- H – hand
- Q – quick mask
- V – move
- W – magic wand
- K – slice
- B – brush
- Y – history brush
- G – gradient/paint bucket
- O – dodge/burn/sponge
- T – type
- U – rectangle
- I – eyedropper
- Z – zoom

GENERAL COMMANDS

- space bar
- held down brings up hand tool for moving around on a zoomed in area of your image.
- held down brings up hand tool for moving around on a zoomed in area of your image.
- command + space bar
- zoom in tool. – zoom in tool. option + command + space bar
- zoom out tool. – zoom out tool. command + S – save. command + P – print.
- command + Z – undo/redo.
- command + C – copy.
- command + V – paste.
- command + 0 (zero) – fit image on screen.

SELECTION COMMANDS

- command + A – select all.
- command + D – deselect.
- command + H – hide/show crawling ants around a selection.
- shift – when making a rectangular or elliptical marquee selection or transforming a selection, holding
- shift key down maintains a perfect circle/square or maintains proportions of your original selection.
- command + J – copy selection to a new layer.
- command + T – free transform.
- arrow keys – move a selection one pixel at a time.

BRUSHES AND COLOR

- [] – increase/decrease brush size.
- X – switches foreground and background colors.
- D – reinstates default colors (black foreground and white background).
